EA = Easy Access Wheelchair user - friendly (up to 5 miles) Children must be accompanied by a parent / guardian

Carers and walkers with special needs must discuss the suitability of the walk with the leader in advance

E = Easy Few obstructions, perhaps a few gentle climbs, good surfaces (up to 5 miles)

L = Leisurely Field and other unsurfaced paths. May be hilly, could include stiles, stepping stones etc.

M = Moderate As (L) and moorland. May include sustained and / or steep climbs.

S = Strenuous Rough paths and mountains. Ascents and descents may be many or long.

Bring packed lunch on walks over 5 miles with a.m. start. Passengers in cars are invited to contribute at the rate of 8p per mile

Owners should check with leader before bringing a dog on any walk
