

How to use your Smartphone to Report a Footpath Problem on site.

1/	From the App store download and install Grid Reference on your smart phone	
2/	Take a photograph of the problem	
3/	Stand near the problem and Click-on the Grid Reference App to display the locations grid reference	
4/	Click-on the Email icon in the display	
5/	<p>Enter the Following data to the Lancashire public right of way Team. You may also want to email it back to yourself and include the Chorley Ramblers address</p> <p>The Text will automatically include your grid location. Enter some text to display the problem and give as much information as possible. See example on the right</p>	<p>From: your email address to: prowreports@lancashire.gov.uk cc: your email address cc: chorleyprow@gmail.com Subject: e.g. Broken Stile</p> <hr/> <p>SJ 805 973 = Grid Reference Top rung of the stile is Broken Health and Safety Issue. <p>Click send and its Job Done. Remember temporary problems like path overgrown or flooding may not get a very high priority while a Health and safety issue may. If your smartphone does not have mobile data then the email will be sent when you come into your wifi area</p>
